Innovation and Innovation Management minitrack

This minitrack will feature interesting and original research results or business practices at the crossroads of Technology and Business. We invite research papers on new models of theory and practice in innovation and innovation management. We are particularly interested in studies that show how technology has been a key enabler for the creation of market and business innovations. The papers submitted for the minitrack will go through double blind reviewing. Selected papers will be featured in minitrack sessions. These papers will appear in the proceedings. Authors of other papers will be given the option of presenting their research results in the symposium on innovation and innovation management described below.

Innovation and Innovation Management Symposium

The symposium offers an avenue for discussing research work or new business practices in progress for obtaining useful and constructive feedback. Symposium can also be used to identify potential research collaborators. Articles submitted to the symposium will not be reviewed. Papers will be selected based on their potential for generating discussions if the number of articles submitted exceeds the capacity. Articles presented at the symposium will be listed in the program and will not be featured in the proceedings. We are currently exploring the possibility of publishing extended versions of selected papers presented in the symposium in a special issue of a magazine similar to IEEE Computer or Communications of the ACM. This publication option has not been firmed up at this point in time.

Full papers submission deadline (to be announced soon- mid June)

- Authors to submit full papers to the Peer Review System, following Author Instructions found on the HICSS web site (<u>www.hicss.hawaii.edu</u>). All papers will be submitted in <u>double column</u> publication format and <u>limited to 10 pages including diagrams and references</u>. Papers undergo a double-blind review.

Notification of results (date to be announced soon - August)

- Acceptance/Rejection notices are sent to Authors via the Peer Review System.

Final paper submission deadline (to be announced soon- mid September)

- Authors submit Final Version of papers following submission instructions on the Peer Review System website. At least one author of each paper must register by this date with specific plans to attend the conference to present the paper. Prices may change for 2007, but for planning purposes, in 2006
